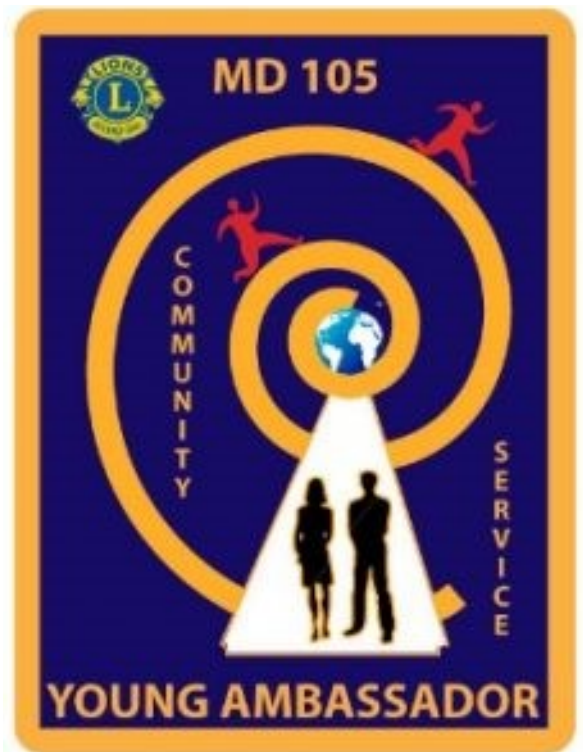

THE AWARD SCHEME RUNS FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF REGISTRATION

THE AWARD SCHEME

RECOGNISES YOUNG PEOPLE FOR THEIR SERVICE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

BRONZE SEAL AWARD - FOR 25 - 29 HOURS SERVICE

SILVER SEAL AWARD - FOR 50 - 99 HOURS SERVICE

GOLD SEAL AWARD - FOR 100 OR MORE HOURS SERVICE

UPON COMPLETION THE YOUNG PERSON WILL RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE AND A YOUNG LEADERS IN SERVICE PIN OR CLOTH BADGE

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

THERE ARE MINIMAL FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS TO THE CLUB INVOLVED WITH THE YOUNG LEADERS IN SERVICE SCHEME.

HOWEVER, CLUBS SHOULD CONSIDER ORGANISING A PRESENTATION EVENT, ONCE OR TWICE A YEAR TO CELEBRATE THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THESE YOUNG PEOPLE. THIS WILL GAIN ADDITIONAL PUBLICITY FOR THE LIONS CLUB - INCREASE AWARENESS AND INVOLVE THE FAMILY AND FRIENDS OF THOSE TAKING PART.

THE AIM OF THE COMPETITION

IS TO SPONSOR PEACE WITHIN OUR COMMUNITY & ACROSS THE WORLD. USING PEACE AS THE OVERRIDING THEME ALONG WITH A DIFFERENT YEARLY SUB TITLE. 2023 - 24 IS "**DARE TO DREAM**". FOR THOSE VISUALLY IMPAIRED THEY CAN TAKE PART BY CREATING AN ESSAY USING THE SAME THEME OF NO MORE THAN 500 WORDS

SUPPORTED BY LIONS CLUBS AROUND THE GLOBE FOR THE PAST THREE DECADES WITH MORE THAN FOUR MILLION YOUNG PEOPLE FROM OVER 100 COUNTRIES TAKING PART.

FEBRUARY 1st INTERNATIONAL WINNERS WILL BE NOTIFIED ON OR BEFORE THIS DATE.

JUDGING

INTERNATIONAL JUDGES ARE TAKEN FROM THOSE WITH A BACKGROUND IN ART - PEACE - YOUTH - EDUCATION OR MEDIA COMMUNITIES. AN OVERALL INTERNATIONAL WINNER WILL BE CHOSEN ALONG WITH 23 MERIT WINNERS

TIMESCALE OF EVENTS

JANUARY - JUNE

LIONS CLUB TO DECIDE & BUDGET FOR SUPPORTING SCHOOLS IN THEIR AREA TO ENTER THE LIONS ROAR PROJECT.

HAVING AGREED THE BUDGET IDENTIFY POTENTIAL PRIMARY SCHOOLS

COLLECT REGISTRATION INFORMATION FROM SCHOOLS TAKING PART & FORWARD TO 8BILLION IDEAS.

FORWARD RELEVANT ENTRY PAYMENT TO DISTRICT TREASURER & REGISTER SCHOOLS ONTO SYSTEM.

FULL TEACHERS PACK WILL BE FORWARDED TO PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS AND LIONS CLUBS NOMINATED ROAR OFFICER

SEPTEMBER:

PROGRAMME WILL BEGIN IN SCHOOLS

NOVEMBER:

SCHOOLS & CLUBS SELECT WINNING ENTRY & A VIDEO PRODUCED.

WINNING ENTRIES FORWARDED TO 8BILLION IDEAS WHO WILL THEN SEND THEM ONTO THE DISTRICT FOR JUDGING.

DISTRICT JUDGING TAKES PLACE

DECEMBER:

NATIONAL AWARDS DAY - VIA ZOOM WITH ALL SCHOOLS TAKING PART.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

CLUB: £170 PER SCHOOL ENTERED (*SENT TO DISTRICT TREASURER*)

HOWEVER DUE TO FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS INVOLVEMENT BY CLUBS IN
YOUTH CAMPS & YOUTH EXCHANGE PROJECTS PLANNING SHOULD TAKE
PLACE AT LEAST TWELVE MONTHS PRIOR TO EXCHANGE & CAMPS TAKING
PLACE.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

THE SPONSORING CLUB WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR A ONE OFF FEE TO LIONS INTERNATIONAL OF \$100 OR THE NATIONAL CURRENCY EQUIVALENT (£85 STERLING)

ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL DUES £85

THE SPONSORING CLUB MAY ALSO WISH TO PROVIDE SOME OF THE LEOS CLUBS REGALIA.

INVESTMENT IN OUR FUTURE IS IMPORTANT

LIONS YOUTH PROJECTS REQUIRE A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF FUNDING IN ADDITION TO THE FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED.

105CW RECOMMEND AN ANNUAL PAYMENT OF £4 PER MEMBER BE PAID WITH THE FIRST HALF YEARS DISTRICT DUES.

THIS MONEY THEN GOES TO THE MD FOUNDATION AND HELPS FUND THE YOUTH CAMPS ORGANISED WITHIN THE U.K. - SUPPORT FOR THE YOUNG AMBASSADOR OF THE YEAR AWARD AND ALSO SUPPORT THE LIONS ROAR PROJECT.
